

Town of White Springs, Florida
Second Public Hearing Notice

The Town of White Springs plans to apply to FloridaCommerce for an FFY 2025 Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) of \$936,300 in the Neighborhood Revitalization category. The activities, dollar amounts and estimated percentage of benefit to low- and moderate-income persons are as follows:

Water Line Replacement	\$781,900	100%

The Town’s AMI water meter replacement project will involve replacing approximately 410 existing residential water meter assemblies with AMI meter assemblies; an AMI System Network (hardware and install), AMI billing software/interface, training and support. This project will have townwide benefits.

The Town does not expect that anyone will be permanently displaced as a result of CDBG-funded activities. If any persons are displaced as a result of the planned activities, the Town will assist them as described in its anti-displacement and relocation policy, which is available for review at Town Hall.

A public hearing to provide citizens an opportunity to comment on the application will be held at Town Hall, 10363 Bridge Street, White Springs, FL 32096, on May 12, 2026, at 6:00 PM. A draft copy of the application will also be available for review during normal business hours at Town Hall by noon on May 12, 2026. A copy of the final application will be available for review at Town Hall no later than May 19, 2026. The application will be submitted to FloridaCommerce on or before May 20, 2026.
