PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE

TO: RESIDENTS OF THE TOWN OF WHITE SPRINGS LIVING IN THE AREA BOUNDED BY OSCEOLA STREET, NORRIS RD., 161<sup>ST</sup> AVE., SE 103<sup>RD</sup> TERR., SE CR 25A, AND 160<sup>TH</sup> PLACE.

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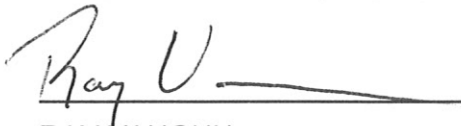
A LOSS OF WATER PRESSURE HAS BEEN EXPERIENCED DUE TO A WATER MAIN BREAK.

**DO NOT DRINK THE WATER WITHOUT BOILING IT FIRST OR USE BOTTLED WATER.** BRING ALL WATER TO A ROLLING BOIL FOR AT LEAST (3) MINUTES, AND LET IT COOL BEFORE USING, OR USE BOTTLED WATER. BOILED OR BOTTLED WATER SHOULD BE USED FOR DRINKING, MAKING ICE, BRUSHING TEETH, WASHING DISHES, AND FOOD PREPERATION UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE. BOILING KILLS BACTERIA AND OTHER ORGANISMS IN THE WATER. RESIDENTS THAT ARE CONCERNED WITH THE SAFETY OF THEIR WATER DURING THIS TIME MAY USE OTHER SOURCES OF DRINKING WATER, SUCH AS BOTTLED WATER.

ALL STORED WATER, DRINK OR ICE MADE FROM THIS SUPPLY DURING THIS PERIOD, SHOULD BE DISCARDED.

THIS "PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER NOTICE" WILL REMAIN IN EFFECT UNTIL THE PROBLEM HAS BEEN CORRECTED AND A BACTERIOLOGICAL SURVEY SHOWS THAT THE WATER IS SAFE TO DRINK AND WATER QUALITY HAS BEEN RESTORED.
