**Ordinance No. 2026-03**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WHITE SPRINGS, FLORIDA, PROPOSING SIX (6) AMENDMENTS TO THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF WHITE SPRINGS; SUBMITTING SUCH AMENDMENTS TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE TOWN FOR APPROVAL OR REJECTION AT THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON APRIL 28, 2026; DIRECTING THE TOWN CLERK TO PROVIDE REQUIRED NOTICES; ATTACHING AS EXHIBIT A THE BALLOT FORMAT FOR EACH PROPOSED AMENDMENT AND AS EXHIBIT B THE FULL TEXT OF EACH PROPOSED AMENDMENT WITH PROPOSED CHARTER LANGUAGE; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF APPROVED AMENDMENTS INTO THE TOWN CHARTER; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE
